

# National Taipei University of Education Academic Research Reward

1. To effectively promote scientific and technological research, enhance teaching and research standards, and encourage staff to participate in foreign academic activities to promote academic exchanges, National Taipei University of Education (hereinafter referred to as the school) established the Directions in accordance with the "National Colleges and Universities Directions of Science/Technology Research and Development Promotion Funds and Utilization" promulgated by the Ministry of Education.
2. Application Requirements: The published works with the school's byline by the school's teachers in the previous year (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31).
3. Reward Items:
  - (1) Academic Monographs
    1. For original academic publications with more than 100,000 words (excluding degree thesis/dissertation and publications for faculty promotion), NT\$20,000 is rewarded for each publication.
    2. For single essays published in overseas foreign language academic monographs with dual examination and review system, NT\$10,000 is rewarded for each essay.
    3. For single essays published in domestic foreign language academic monographs with dual examination and review system, NT\$5,000 is rewarded for each essay.
  - (2) Academic Journal Articles
    1. Articles published in SCI or SCIE (Science Citation Index), SSCI (Social Sciences Citation Index), or AHCI (Arts & Humanities Citation Index) database, NT\$20,000 is rewarded for each article.
    2. Articles published in TSSCI (Taiwan Social Science Citation Index), ERIC--EJ (Educational Resources Information Center--Current Index to Journals ), SCOPUS or THCI (Taiwan Humanities Citation Index) database, NT\$10,000 is rewarded for each article.
    3. Articles published in the "foreign academic journals recommended by the school faculties", NT\$10,000 is rewarded for each article.
    4. Articles published in the "domestic academic journals recommended by the school faculties", NT\$5,000 is rewarded for each article.
  - (3) Special Exhibitions/Performances, Creations and Inventions
    1. For award-winners or representatives of the country to participate in domestically and internationally organized international exhibitions/performances, each case can be awarded up to NT\$20,000.
    2. For award-winners in national or international awards held in Taiwan or China, each case can be awarded up to NT\$10,000.
    3. For participating in the national exhibitions/performances, each case is awarded up to

NT\$5,000.

The upper limit and the total amount of the annual subsidy shall be subject to "the Annual Budget Allocation Meeting".

4. Rewarding Principles:

- (1) Up to 2 cases can be subsidized per person per year.
- (2) Those who apply for the Directions shall be listed as the first author or the second author or the corresponding author; only for applicants of Point 3 Paragraph 2 Subparagraph 4, listed as the first author or the corresponding author is required.
- (3) If more than 2 faculty teachers co-authoring, only one person is rewarded as the principle.
- (4) Based on the one-case-one-reward principle, the same case which has received reward (subsidy) on-campus or off-campus shall not reapply for the reward.

5. Application Period:

- (1) Every year from September 1st to September 15th, applicants fill in the application form (see the attached) enclosed with certified documents and submit the application to the affiliated department/institute.
- (2) Before September 30th each year, department/institute shall submit the preliminary results to its affiliated college.
- (3) Before October 31st each year, the college shall submit the review results to Integrated Planning Division under R&D Office.

6. Review Procedure:

- (1) Preliminary: A preliminary review is carried out after the applications have been collected.
- (2) Review: Department/institute submits the preliminary results to its affiliated college for review.
- (3) Final Consideration: Integrated Planning Division under R&D Office collects and compiles the review results submitted by the college, and invites the Academic Committee members, i.e. President, Vice President, Deans and Director Of Comptroller to make the final consideration.
- (4) Announcement: The review results shall be announced by Research and Development Office within 3 weeks after the final consideration.

7. Source of Funding: This shall be covered by two-thirds of the "Science/Technology Research and Development Promotion Funds" and the self-raised income of the school funds.

8. For relevant academic rewards and audit related matters, an academic development committee shall be set up for further consultation; the directions for its establishment shall be made separately.

9. The Directions are passed by the Administrative Council and the Endowment Fund Management Committee, and implemented after approved by the President.
