

ABOUT NTUE

The National Taipei University of Education (NTUE) began in 1895 as National Taipei Teachers College, is the oldest educational institution in Taiwan. Renamed to its present title in 2005, NTUE comprises of three colleges: Education, Humanities and Arts, and Science, and offers undergraduate and graduate programs, including two All-English Masters Program in Fine Arts and Education.

The university is centrally located in the heart of Taipei, on 7.5 hectares of land, with a major MRT (Technology Station Building) station only 450m away. Our widely acclaimed Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) receives more than 2000 students from over 40 countries from ages 6 to 50 to learn Mandarin Chinese language every year.
