

NTUE Departmental Invitation for Current/Former Editor In Chief of Internationally Renowned Journals for Seminar/Conference Directive

A. Objective

The NTUE Departmental Invitation for Current/Former Editor In Chief of Internationally Renowned Journals for Seminar/Conference Directive is set forth in order to improve the academic atmosphere of the University and offer the faculty and students an opportunity for academic exchange and collaboration, thus developing the specialty of academic research within the University.

B. Principles

Each year 2 departments/institutes shall receive subsidization in inviting current/former editor in chiefs of SCI, SSCI, EI, AHCI journals, amongst others, to attend and participate in a seminar/conference.

C. Application Period

- (1) All departments/institutes shall submit their seminar/conference draft proposal for the next year to the International Affairs Division, R&D Office prior to Sep. 30th each year.
- (2) The R&D Office shall confirm the priority of the subsidization prior to Oct. 10th.
- (3) Departments/institutes shall contact guests as designated in the order list announced prior to Nov. 15th and submit a detailed plan. Failing to do so before the deadline shall be seen as waiving the opportunity and the next proposal shall be considered instead.
- (4) Seminar/conference shall be held prior to Dec. 15th of the next year.

D. Subsidy Standard

Each such seminar/conference shall receive a subsidy of TW\$100,000 in total.

E. Funding

The funding of this subsidy shall be expensed by the Academic Development Funding budgeted by the University; the organizing departments/institutes shall apply for subsidization from third parties outside the University.

F. The Directive has been agreed upon by the Administrative Meeting, and shall be submitted for approval by the President before being implemented. Its amendment shall follow suit.
