C. APPLICATION	
Academic Requirement	Application will only be considered through the nomination submitted by partner institutions.
Chinese Proficiency Requirement	<p>1. Except for Chinese native speaker or students major in Chinese, Proof of TOCFL Level 3(formerly Basic) or equivalent level such as HSK5, 中国語檢定試驗 3 級 is required at the time of Exchange Application submission for applicant of Department of Language and Creative Writing if not major in Chinese.</p> <p>2. Optional for other departments applicant and Chinese native speaker. But obtaining intermediate Chinese proficiency is highly encouraged before arrival, since most of courses are taught in Chinese at NTUE.</p> <p>3. Should his or her instructor find it necessary, an exchange student is suggested to take free Mandarin courses (15 hours a week) at the Chinese Language Education Center to improve his / her Chinese proficiency at NTUE. The Mandarin courses are 0 credits, but students can receive transcript and certificate if their scores over 70 and at least 3/4 attendance of last session that could be waived depending on home institution.</p>

The system will send you a default password to access the website. Please log in and change your password freely, then complete your application online before the deadline. 6. Photo(jpg):

1) *Thin half-length color photo with a glossy finish taken with a **white background** within the last one year that should be **4.5cm X 3.5cm** with an image of the head that should not be shorter than 3.2cm or longer than 3.6cm from the top of the head to the chin, without wearing a hat or a pair of color glasses, with clear facial features not covered and identifiable, and should not be modified or composed.*

2) *Student staying in Taiwan over 180 days needs to bring a hard copy of photo for ARC application.*

7. Certificate of Health: Choose one depending on the duration of stay.

Required items must be included

1) [Health Certificate for Short-Term Students](#)- *For foreign students who intend to stay in Taiwan for more than three months, but less than 6 months or Chinese students who intend to stay in Taiwan for more than two months, but less than 6 months.*

2) [Health Certificate for Residence Application](#)- *For foreign students who intend to stay in Taiwan for more than 6 months.*

8. Financial Statement: balance over **US\$ 5000** for 1 year officially issued by bank

9. Certificate/Proof of Language Proficiency

(1) Certificate/Proof of Chinese Proficiency

a. *Certificate of TOCFL 3 or [equivalent level](#) such as [HSK5](#), [中國語檢定試驗 3級](#) is required for applicant of Department of Language and Creative Writing if not major in Chinese.*

b. *Applicant of Department of Language and Creative Writing Students should provide certificate or related proof such as transcript if major in Chinese.*

c. *Optional for other departments applicant and Chinese native speaker.*

(2) Certificate/Proof of English Proficiency

Optional, but student intends to apply for Dept. Children English Education is strongly suggested to have B2 level of English Proficiency.

Alien Residence Certificates (ARC) Application Fee	<p>Those who enter Taiwan on a Resident Visa or get a Resident Visa after having arrived in Taiwan must apply for an Alien Resident Certificate and Re-entry Permit at National Immigration Agency (No. 15, Guangzhou St., Zhongzheng District, Taipei City 100-66) which must apply within 15 days from the next day of arrival or apply within 15 days from the Resident Visa issuance date. Duration of stay is noted on the Alien Resident Certificate.</p>
Insurance	<p>All international students are required to have medical and accident insurance in home country to cover your medical expenses during your entire stay in Taiwan before enroll in the NHI Program. Please offer the copy of insurance proof after receiving the Letter of Acceptance from NTUE.</p> <p>According to National Health Insurance Act in Taiwan, international students staying in Taiwan for at least 6 months and holding ARC are mandatory to enroll in the National Health Insurance (NHI) Program which cost NT\$ 749 per month.</p>
Pick-up service	<p>Free pick-up service is available on specified date(s). Please offer date and flight number at least 1 month earlier before arrival.</p>
